Renewable Natural Gas Pilot in the PGW Service Area

To celebrate our 40th Anniversary, the Energy Co-op is launching its renewable natural gas (RNG) pilot program in the PGW service area on October 1st! These members in the PGW service area, who signed up from the pilot program earlier in the summer, will now be able to participate in a program that reduces both the quantity of landfill gas inefficiently flared to the atmosphere AND natural gas extracted by drilling, hydraulic fracturing, or other destructive means. In addition, proceeds from their RNG purchases will be used to advance the Energy Co-op's mission of helping Philadelphians affordably and sustainably buy, use, and understand energy. The program will initially be available to only those who pre-registered, but keep an eye out for our wide release to everyone in the PGW service area scheduled for November!

NEW! Home Energy Efficiency Audit Program

We are also pleased to announce our new partnership with the Energy Coordinating Agency to offer our members one of the most comprehensive home energy audits available. This program is designed to help our members use energy as efficiently and responsibly as possible, while helping reduce their utility bills.
